

Final Project of Professional Growth

Students will submit a presentation of professional growth by way of a freely chosen version of a storymap. The presentation should include the following components:

- First, a brief introduction of themselves, their background, and their goals regarding their involvement in the study abroad program.
- Second, a detailed description of events of the program throughout the duration of the travel.
 - include home stay experience, cultural excursions, and site visits (schools and NGO's)
- Third, students will share 2-3 transformative moments in which they encountered challenges they faced during their program, as well as, expressing what they learned about themselves from this.
- Fourth, students will describe how they will apply this experience to their professional development. How did the experience contribute to your perspective about the world around you, understanding yourself as a professional, and how this contributed to a deepened understanding of your field of practice (in your chosen major/minor areas).
- Weekly Journal artifacts/field notes will be collected and included in final presentation. Please submit the link or file to your weekly journal in the assignment [here](#).
 - *it's a good idea to have an ongoing collection of these field notes and artifacts as you experience each day to help you gather your thoughts and reflect at the culmination of the program*
